



SHUSWAP RINGETTE ASSOCIATION GAME JERSEY RESPONSIBILITY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Shuswap Ringette is providing your daughter/son with two game jerseys, at an approximate value of \$125 each, to use while representing Shuswap Ringette. We ask that you acknowledge the conditions as follows while using these jerseys:

- Game Jersey's are only to be worn for Shuswap Ringette Games, Tournaments or other functions representing Shuswap Ringette as directed by the Coaching Staff.
- Game Jersey's will **NOT** be worn for practices. Players will be asked to leave the ice and may return only when they are wearing an appropriate practice jersey.
- Players are responsible to provide their own practice jersey.
- Name Bars and C's should be either hand sewn or machine basted onto the jersey. No "iron-on" substances will be used to affix anything onto the jersey.
- Name Bars will be carefully removed at the end of each playing season by the Parent/Guardian prior to the return of the jerseys, or it will be removed by the Equipment Manager. Shuswap Ringette Association will not be responsible for name bars.
- Game Jersey's must be returned to the Team Manager within two (2) of the last game played, or as directed by the Team Manager, in the same condition as when they were issued.
- Parents/Guardians/Players should notify the Team Manager and/or Equipment Manager immediately of any lost, stolen or damaged jerseys.
- If a jersey is lost or stolen, no replacement jersey shall be issued to a player until the replacement costs have been paid in full by the Parent/Guardian to Shuswap Ringette.
- Parent/Guardian is responsible for all replacement costs of the jersey, at current replacement value.
- No monies shall be returned/refunded by the Shuswap Ringette Association, to a Player/Parent/Guardian, until the Game Jersey's are returned to the Shuswap Ringette in the same condition as when they were issued.
- Jersey's should be machine washed and completely dried after each use to prevent mold.

SHUSWAP RINGETTE GAME JERSEY POLICY

1. Game Jersey's are issued to each registered Shuswap Ringette player only after both the Parent/Guardian and Player have signed the "Jersey Responsibility Acknowledgement Form".
2. Game Jersey's are only to be worn for Shuswap Ringette Games, Tournaments or other functions representing Shuswap Ringette as directed by the Coaching Staff.
3. Game Jersey's will NOT be worn for practices. Players will be asked to leave the ice and may return when they are wearing an appropriate practice jersey.
4. Players are responsible to provide their own practice jersey.
5. Name Bars and C's should be either hand sewn or machine basted onto the jersey. No iron on substances will be used to affix anything onto the jersey.
6. Name Bars will be carefully removed at the end of each playing season by the parent/guardian prior to the return of the jerseys, or it will be removed by the Equipment Manager. Shuswap Ringette will not be responsible for any lost name bars.
7. Game Jersey's must be returned to the Team Manager within two (2) weeks of the last game played, in the same condition as when it was issued, or as directed by the Team Manager.
8. Parents/Guardians/Players should notify the Team Manager and/or Equipment Manager immediately of any lost, stolen or damaged jerseys.
9. If a jersey is lost or stolen, no replacement jersey shall be issued to a player until the replacement costs have been paid in full to Shuswap Ringette.
10. Parent/Guardian is responsible for all replacement costs of the jersey, at current replacement value.
11. No monies shall be returned or refunded by the Shuswap Ringette Association, to a Player/Parent/Guardian, until the Game Jersey's are returned to the Shuswap Ringette Association in good condition.
12. Each Team Manager is responsible for keeping a list of players and the jersey's assigned (see attached), as well as the Responsibility Forms. Team Managers will report any misuse of jersey's to the Equipment Manager.
13. Team Manager will be responsible to collect all jerseys at the end of the playing season and return to the teams designated locker within two (2) weeks of the end of the playing season.
14. Team Manager will report any missing jersey's to the Equipment Manager within two (2) weeks of the end of the playing season.
15. If a player has not returned their jersey/jerseys from previous year(s), no jersey(s) will be issued for the current playing season.
